

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

Introduction

These terms and conditions apply between you, the User of this Website (including any sub-domains, unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions), and Hytex Holdings Limited, the owner and operator of this Website. Please read these terms and conditions carefully, as they affect your legal rights. Your agreement to comply with and be bound by these terms and conditions is deemed to occur upon your first use of the Website. If you do not agree to be bound by these terms and conditions, you should stop using the Website immediately.

In these terms and conditions, **User** or **Users** means any third party that accesses the Website and is not either (i) employed by Hytex Holdings Limited and acting in the course of their employment or (ii) engaged as a consultant or otherwise providing services to Hytex Holdings Limited and accessing the Website in connection with the provision of such services.

You must be at least 18 years of age to use this Website. By using the Website and agreeing to these terms and conditions, you represent and warrant that you are at least 18 years of age.

Intellectual property and acceptable use

1. All Content included on the Website, unless uploaded by Users, is the property of Hytex Holdings Limited, our affiliates or other relevant third parties. Registration

7. You must ensure that the details provided by you on registration or at any time are correct and complete.

9. We may suspend or cancel your registration with immediate effect for any reasonable purposes or if you breach these terms and conditions.
10. You may cancel your registration at any time by informing us in writing to the address at the end of these terms and conditions. If you do so, you must immediately stop using the Website. Cancellation or suspension of your registration does not affect any statutory rights.

Password and security

11. When you register on this Website, you will be asked to create a password, which you should keep confidential and not disclose or share with anyone.
12. If we have reason to believe that there is or is likely to be any misuse of the Website or breach of security, we may require you to change your password or suspend your account.

These terms and conditions shall continue to apply to any modified version of the Website unless it is expressly stated otherwise.

Limitation of liability

18. Nothing in these terms and conditions will: (a) limit or exclude our or your liability for death or personal injury resulting from our or your negligence, as applicable; (b) limit or exclude our or your liability for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or (c) limit or exclude any of our or your liabilities in any way that is not permitted under applicable law.
19. We will not be liable to you in respect of any losses arising out of events beyond our reasonable control.
20. To the maximum extent permitted by law, Hytex Holdings Limited accepts no liability for any of the following:
 - a. any business losses, such as loss of profits, income, revenue, anticipated savings, business, contracts, goodwill or commercial opportunities;
 - b. loss or corruption of any data, database or software;
 - c. any special, indirect or consequential loss or damage.

General

21. You may not transfer any of your rights under these terms and conditions to any other person. We may transfer our rights under these terms and conditions where we reasonably believe your rights will not be affected.
22. These terms and conditions may be varied by us from time to time. Such revised terms will apply to the Website from the date of publication. Users should check the terms and conditions regularly to ensure familiarity with the then current version.
23. These terms and conditions together with the Privacy Policy contain the whole agreement between the parties relating to its subject matter and supersede all prior discussions, arrangements or agreements that might have taken place in relation to the terms and conditions.
24. The Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 shall not apply to these terms and conditions and no third party will have any right to enforce or rely on any provision of these terms and conditions.
25. If any court or competent authority finds that any provision of these terms and conditions (or part of any provision) is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision or part-provision will, to the extent required, be deemed to be deleted, and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of these terms and conditions will not be affected.
26. Unless otherwise agreed, no delay, act or omission by a party in exercising any right or remedy will be deemed a waiver of that, or any other, right or remedy.

27. This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted according to the law of England and Wales and all disputes arising under the Agreement (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English and Welsh courts.

Acceptable Usage Policy

28. You may not use our services to publish content or engage in activity that is harmful to others or is illegal under the applicable law (this includes both the local and international laws, respectively), including, but not limited in connection with any of the following illegal, harmful or fraudulent activities: Child Pornography – Hosting, distributing, or linking to pornography involving a person under the legal age.

Forgery – Faking an IP address, host name, e-mail address, or header.

Fraudulent Websites – Hosting or linking to websites that are intended to deceive the public; including, but not limited to sites listed at aa419.org and escrow-fraud.com.

HYIP – Hosting or linking to a high yield investment program website.

Identity Theft – Hosting, distributing, or linking to stolen account identification.

Infection – Hosting, distributing, or linking to exploits, trojans, viruses, bot-nets or worms.

Intellectual Property Infringement – Hosting, distributing, or linking to infringing content.

Investment Websites – Hosting, distributing, or linking to FOREX, e-gold exchange, second life/Linden Exchange, Ponzi, MLM/pyramid scheme, high-yield interest programs (HYIP) or other related websites.

IRC – Hosting, distributing, or linking to internet relay chat servers, including IRC scripts and bots.

Mass Storage – Storing mass amounts of backups, archives, videos, etc.

PayDay Loan Websites – Including any website related to PayDay loans, PayDay loan affiliate programs, etc.

Pharmacy Websites – Websites that engage in the illegal distribution of prescription medications; including, but not limited to: promotion, marketing, or sale of prescription medications without a valid prescription or license.

Phishing – Taking part in identity theft by e-mail or other means under false presence.

Proxy Website – Hosting or linking to anonymous proxy servers.

Bulk E-mail – No more than 500 e-mails of similar content can be stored, sent or received (Opt In).

Spam E-mail – Indulging in unsolicited commercial e-mails (UCE) or unsolicited bulk e-mails (UBE).

Spam List – Hosting, distributing, or linking to e-mail address lists or databases for spam purposes.

Spam Website – Hosting, distributing, or linking to a website that is or has been advertised by spam e-mails or other spam or fraudulent websites.

Spam Software – Hosting, distributing, or linking to software designed and developed for spamming or robo-calling (e.g. VOIP).

Spam Website – Indulging in unsolicited, bulk, or forged website advertisement in website logs, forums, guest-books, or social media.

Terrorist Website – Hosting or linking to a website advocating terrorism.

Toolz – Hosting, distributing, or linking to ‘toolz’ or instructional material on hacking and cracking software and systems or other illegal activities.

Warez – Hosting, distributing, or linking to ‘crackz’, ‘hackz’, ‘keyGenz’, ‘serialz’, or other pirated software.

Any other content or activity that is harmful to others or is illegal under applicable law as determined by Silky Servers in its sole discretion.

Refunds

29. We only offer a no questions asked refund within the first 24 hours of your first invoice being paid. No refunds are offered beyond this period. All refunds are subject to a 25% administration fee. This refund offer is only valid for new customers, a refund cannot be claimed by an existing customer.

Disputes and Chargebacks

30. We do not tolerate any sort of charge-backs or disputes, including PayPal disputes. Thus, we reserve the right to suspend and/or terminate your services without notice, should you file any kind of financial dispute against us. We also reserve the right to close your account without any notice. We advise all customers to contact us directly to settle any issues.
31. We reserve the right to terminate any applicable contracts in the case of any kind of financial or non-financial disputes and / or charge backs. A compensation fee of £100 GBP will also be charged in the case of such fraudulent activity. We advise all customers to contact us directly to settle any issues.

Debt Collection

32. We reserve the right to pass your case onto a third-party debt collection agency, should we deem this necessary. We may do this if you haven't paid an owed balance to us or if you have charge-backed or disputed a transaction. We may pass some or all of your personal information to the debt collection agency of our choice, as required. We may also pass your case onto any courts, as deemed appropriate.

Late Payments

33. Any service that is not paid in full by the end of the first day of the billing term will be given a 24 hour grace period. If the payment is not made within the 24 hour grace period, Silky Servers reserves the right to suspend and/or terminate the customer's service for non-payment. Any applicable late payment fees may also be charged to the customer.

Abuse & Copyright Infringement

34. As a company, we take server abuse and copyright claims seriously. So, if we receive an abuse report or a DMCA notice, we will forward it to the client and allow up to 24 hours for a reply (their service will be suspended until they respond). If the client continues hosting copyrighted files and/or abusing their services, their service will be terminated without any warnings or a refund and the applicable legal action will be undertaken.
